RE: FORMER MINISTER NKOSINATHI PHIWAYINKOSI THAMSANQA NHLEKO

- 1 As you are aware, the chairperson of the Commission has granted your client, the former Minister of Police, Mr. Nhleko, leave to testify, be questioned and to cross-examine Mr. Robert McBride. The hearing is scheduled for 27 July 2020. A separate notice to this effect should have been sent to you already.
- 2 Mr. Nhleko, as you may recall, was implicated by Mr. McBride, Mr. Innocent Khuba and Mr. Matthews Sesoko. In this regard, we attach hereto the following additional documents:
 - 2.1 The Supplementary Affidavit of Mr. McBride in response to the Werksmans Report.

- 2.2 The affidavit of Mr. Sandile July in response to Mr. McBride's affidavit.

 - 2.5 The affidavit of Mr Sesoko in response to the Werksmans Report.

- 3 Messrs McBride, Khuba and Sesoko are presently considering the responses of Mr. July to their affidavits and will probably file a reply thereto. We will make those available to you as soon as they become available.
 - 4 Although Mr. Nhleko has only been granted leave to cross-examine Mr. McBride, he should prepare to answer questions in respect of Messrs Khuba and Sesoko, as well.
 - 5 We note from Mr. Nhleko's affidavit that he requires a complete copy of the affidavit of Mr. McBride. We understand that this has already been forwarded to you, but as a matter of completeness attach a complete copy of Mr. McBride's previous affidavit, as well. That affidavit together with all attachments are available on the Commission's website: www.sastatecapture.org.za. Please feel free to download any affidavits or attachments from that website.
 - 6 In addition, we attach hereto the affidavit and a transcript of the testimony of Adv. Mahlodi Sam Muofhe relating to his interactions with Mr. Nhleko. Questions may be posed to Mr. Nhleko in relation to those interactions as well. We would appreciate it if Mr Nhleko would provide the Commission with an affidavit relating to the allegations by Adv. Muofhe.
