Request for comments: Advocate Ngoako Ramatlhodi's Affidavit

1. I refer to the affidavit of Advocate Ngoako Ramatlhodi, former Minister of Mineral Resources, which he submitted to the Commission. A copy of that affidavit would have been sent to you prior to Advocate Ramatlhodi testifying before the Commission. However, in case it was not sent or you no longer have it, a copy of that affidavit is attached to this letter for your convenience.

2. In his affidavit Advocate Ramatlhodi referred to a meeting which he said he had with you and another meeting which he said he had with you and Dr Ben Ngubane, who was Chairperson of the Board of Eskom at the time, and he has given a version of what transpired in those two meetings.

3. I have been directed by the Chairperson of the Commission to ask you to furnish the Commission on or before 16h00 on Tuesday, 23 June 2020 with an affidavit or affirmed declaration in which you give your response to those parts of Advocate Ramatlhodi's affidavit where you are mentioned. In this regard, if you admit having been part of one or both of the meetings to which Advocate Ramatlhodi refers, you are requested to give your full version of the content of the discussions in those meetings. We are aware that there is an affidavit that you have furnished to the Commission in which you do say something about the meeting that you and Dr Ngubane had with Advocate Ramatlhodi but you do not appear to give a full account of the content of the discussion in that meeting. You also do not appear to deal with the meeting that Advocate Ramatlhodi says he had with you without Dr Ngubane. In this letter, you are requested to deal with these two meetings fully.

4. If you require assistance by a lawyer in the preparation of your affidavit or your affirmed declaration, the Commission will be able to assist you to prepare the affidavit or affirmed declaration and you will not be charged any fees or costs for that assistance. You are also free to make use of your own lawyer or you may prepare the affidavit or affirmed declaration on your own. If, however, you choose to use your own lawyer, the Commission will not be liable for the payment of your lawyer's fees or costs.

5. You are requested to advise the Commission within 3 calendar days of receipt of this letter whether you undertake to furnish the Commission with the affidavit or affirmed declaration within the stipulated time. If you do not advise the Commission that you will furnish it with the affidavit or affirmed declaration within that time, the Commission will take it that you do not intend to furnish it with the required affidavit or affirmed declaration.

6. Your co-operation will be highly appreciated.
